Player Commitment Agreement

At Brentwood Netball Club, we strive to create a positive and competitive environment that fosters growth, teamwork, and sportsmanship. In order to maintain this atmosphere and ensure fairness to all players, it is crucial that each member fulfils their commitment to training and scheduled games.

We kindly request that you remind your daughter of the following points:

- 1. **Training Attendance:** Regular attendance at training sessions is essential for skill development, team cohesion, and tactical understanding. Missing training sessions without a valid reason may impact your daughter's selection for the next game.
- 2. **Game Participation:** When your daughter commits to playing in a scheduled game, it is important that she honours that commitment. Pulling out of a previously committed game without a valid reason not only disrupts team dynamics but also affects the fairness of team selection for the next game.

We understand that unforeseen circumstances can arise, and valid reasons for missing training or withdrawing from a game will be considered on a case-by-case basis. However, consistent commitment and communication regarding any changes are vital to maintaining a strong, cohesive and dedicated team.

Players who trial and accept a place in a Brentwood Netball Club squad are expected to demonstrate a **strong level of commitment**. If the Coaches or Club feel that this commitment is not being met, we will reach out to understand the reasons behind it. In some cases, a continued lack of commitment, or insufficient explanation, may result in a review of the player's membership.

Brentwood Netball Club operates a **one-club policy**, meaning that players who accept a place in one of our squads are expected to **commit fully** to representing **Brentwood Netball Club only**. This policy is in place to ensure consistency, team cohesion, and a strong level of commitment from all players. If Coaches or the Club feel that a player's commitment is falling below the expected level, we will reach out to discuss the situation. Continued lack of commitment or failure to adhere to the one-club policy may result in a review of the player's membership.

By reinforcing these expectations, we aim to instil in our players the importance of responsibility, commitment, and teamwork, which are valuable life skills that extend beyond the netball court.
